

CONNECT Beyond is a regional mobility initiative that is being led by the Centralina Regional Council and the Charlotte Area Transit System (CATS) and will create a long-term regional transit plan for our two state, 12-county region. This regional transit plan will guide future public transit investments in our region and will serve as a blueprint for how to implement a robust, interconnected public transit network that will combine high capacity transit lines, enhanced bus services, and other innovative mobility solutions.

The goal of creating an interconnected regional transit network is to allow residents and visitors to travel seamlessly throughout our 12-county region – crossing municipal, county, and state lines –aboard modern, high quality public transportation services.

Community Advisory Committee

Policy Advisory Committee

North Carolina and South Carolina elected officials and policy experts from across the CONNECT Beyond region.

Technical Advisory Committee

Technical staff from across the CONNECT Beyond region, who specialize in transportation, land use planning, healthcare, economic devlopment, edcuation and other areas.

Public Involvement

We've been working with community members from around the CONNECT Beyond region for several years to reach this point. CONNECT Beyond builds on two complementary regional visioning and planning initiatives led by the Centralina Regional Council: the CONNECT Our Future Project and the Regional Transit Engagement Series. The CONNECT Beyond Team also hosted an Online Public Meeting & Community Survey to present the candidate High Capacity Transit Corridors that are being considered for the CONNECT Beyond region and seek input from community members.

We are also hosting targeted listening sessions with community members from across the CONNECT Beyond region.

Feedback received from the community will help support, refine, or add to the draft recommendations for CONNECT Beyond's regional transit plan.
