CONSTRUCTION UPDATES

Work is progressing on the new overpasses at Cave Springs and Zumbehl.

Coming up over the next several weeks crews will be setting girders for the second half of the Cave Springs overpass. When that happens motorists can expect a two-lane closure approaching the bridge construction and then 20-minute intermittent full closures of the interstate while girders are swung into place. This work will take place overnight. Once dates and times are finalized, we will send out an updated notification.

Meanwhile at Zumbehl, crews will soon be pouring the deck for the second half of the Zumbehl bridge.
