CONSTRUCTION UPDATES

Coming up in early to mid-December, crews will be setting girders over Interstate 70 at Cave Springs for the new bridge currently being built. This work is weather permitting, and we'll send out an update once the dates are more set.

Similar to last month when girders were set at Zumbehl, the work will require overnight lane restrictions and brief closures of the interstate. Motorists can expect a two-lane closure approaching the bridge construction and then 15-minute intermittent full closures of the interstate while girders are swung into place.

The Cave Springs and Zumbehl interchanges are being converted into single point urban interchanges (SPUI) for the I-70 Cave Springs to Fairgrounds Design-Build Project. As construction on this project progresses, both interchanges will remain open to drivers.



NAVIGATING THE WORKZONE

MoDOT limits work on interstates and state highways during peak holiday travel times. However, traffic will still be restricted in areas where there are permanent barriers, such as the shifted and narrowed lanes on I-70 and on Cave Springs as a part of this project. Please keep this in mind when traveling over the December holidays.

In addition, these barriers will remain up during inclement weather. Please use caution when traveling through the area during winter weather.
