Please confirm the maximum number of pages for Part 3 and, if the total is (6) pages, the submittal requirements of the Key Tasks section.	The three (3) pages allowed for the key tasks were intended to be in addition to the three (3) pages allowed for the executive summary. The key tasks are identified based on the project's needs and may not be addressed by the required key personnel listed in section 3.5. The intent is to provide an opportunity for each Submitter to share their approach to managing the key tasks that they identify as being critical for the success of the project. An addendum will be issued to allow for a six (6) page executive summary that includes the key tasks.	Yes
