## NDOT to implement 9-week closure of Centennial Center Blvd at the future Oso Blanca connection for sewer line installation

**WHEN:** Monday, Sep. 23, 2019, – Saturday, Nov. 23, 2019

**WHAT:** As early as 4 a.m., Monday, Sep. 23, 2019, NDOT will implement a nine-week full closure of Centennial Center Blvd at the future Oso Blanca connection. This closure will be in effect through Saturday, Nov. 23, 2019, in order to install sanitary sewer lines and manholes.

During this closure, drivers traveling east-west on Centennial Center Blvd will still be able to travel through the area but should expect reduced lanes and a traffic shift around the closed portion of the road. Westbound lanes will be fully closed to accommodate construction activities; both eastbound/westbound traffic will be reduced to one lane with westbound traffic shifted to one of the available eastbound lanes. Drivers should plan ahead for reduced speeds and changing traffic configurations.



Working hours will be from 7 a.m. – 3:30 p.m.; however, the closure will remain in place around-the-clock. A safe pedestrian path will be maintained at all times throughout the closure.

**WHERE:** Centennial Center Blvd at the future Oso Blanca connection

**ABOUT THE PROJECT:** Phase 3C of the US 95 Northwest Corridor Improvement Project is the second of three projects that will provide local connections and create a system-to-system interchange at US 95 and CC 215, also known as the Centennial Bowl. This \$73 million project began in January 2019 with anticipated completion in winter 2020. Once complete, the Centennial Bowl will have three new interchange ramp connections and widened freeway capacity on US 95 providing increased safety, improved trip times, and enhanced aesthetics.
