


California's population continues to increase, while affordable housing markets are pushed further away from the urban core, so an integrated multi-modal transportation network is needed to meet statewide mobility and environmental goals. State, Regional and Local Transportation Agencies are working closely to plan for our future mobility and access to those things that matter most: our jobs, families, friends and recreational activities. The California State Rail Plan identifies an integrated rail system that links markets and creates transportation hubs for ease of travel and convenient connections. South Bay Connect is one piece of this larger system that is designed to improve our ability to move and connect people throughout this Northern California Megaregion. A true conduit, Capitol Corridor's Intercity Rail Service links directly to Regional Rail Services throughout 21 counties.





The California State Rail Plan, Regional Rail Plans and Capitol Corridor's 2016 Vision Implementation Plan all seek to improve the movement of goods and people through enhanced rail operations, access and user experience. The South Bay Connect Project is an important step towards achieving these goals within the Bay Area region.
